Do I need an Instagram account? Yes, you need to set up a personal Instagram Account in order to participate. To do this, you will need to add the Instagram app to your smart phone or tablet device. Then, set up an individual account using your personal information. (Do not set it up using your p2p email address).



Okay, I have set up my account. Now what do I do?

- 1) Log into your personal Instagram account
- 2) Click the circle inside the square button located at the bottom of the screen.
- 3) Take the photos
- 4) Click the bottom left button and select the image you want to share, click next.
- 5) (Optional) Edit the visual effects
- 6) Write a brief caption
- 7) Tag P2P by typing @socialp2p #weluvp2p
- 8) Press the share button.
